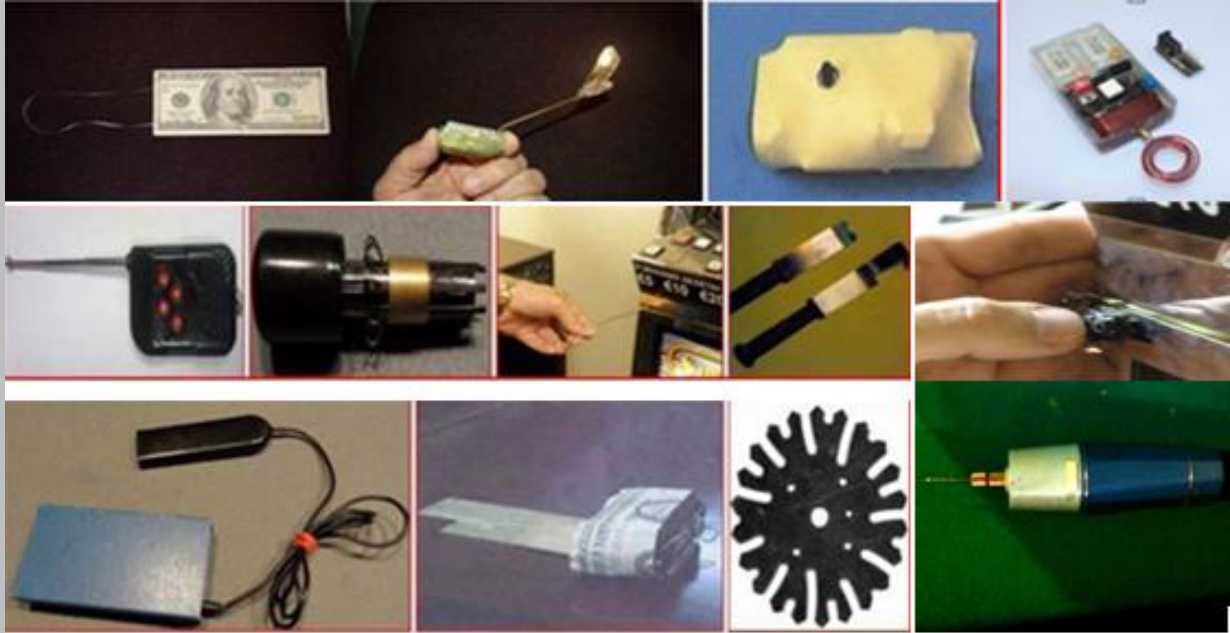

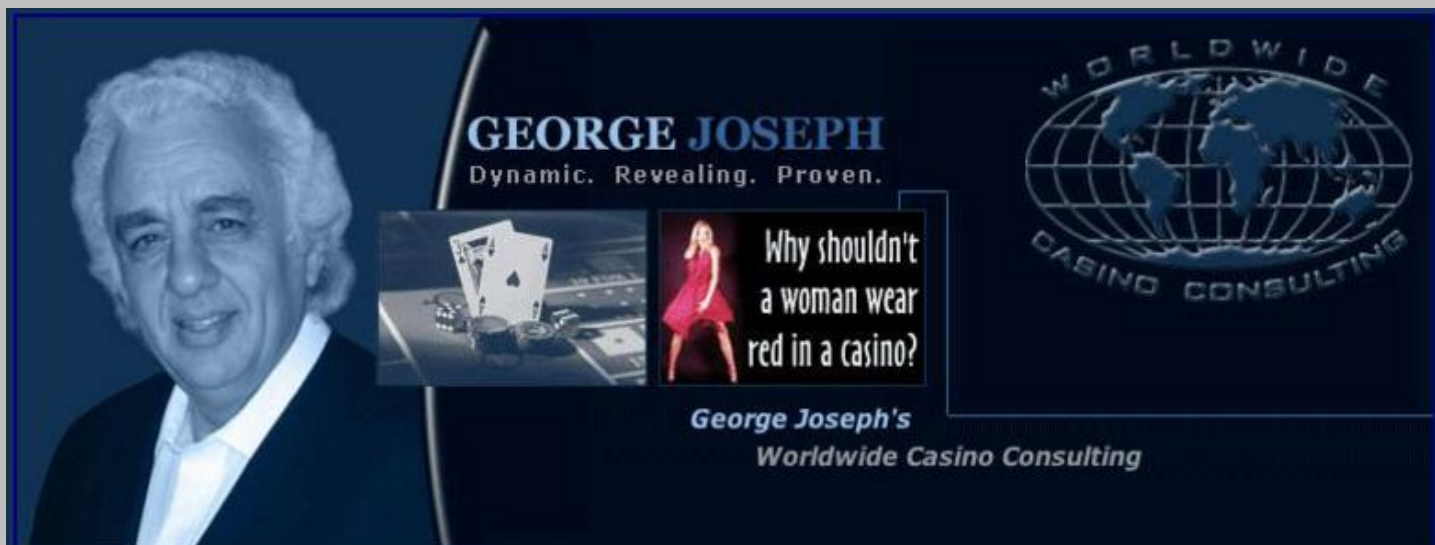

Casino company analyst pleads guilty in \$860,000 slot scheme...May 12, 2012

As an analyst for the state's largest casino company MGM, Tony Ahn was a trusted employee who had access to valuable players club information. Ahn used his company position to identify regular customers with unused free play points, transferred the points to counterfeit players club cards and recruited people to gamble with the cards at the company's casinos along the Strip. Ahn pleaded guilty on Monday before U.S. District Judge James Mahan to three charges: trafficking in, production and use of counterfeit access devices; fraudulent transactions with access devices; and conspiracy to commit access device fraud. That data included the free play points, with personal identification numbers and card numbers needed to access the points.

Ex-casino employee guilty of theft

She gave away \$570,000 in vouchers to five members of the Player's Club
January 9, 2008

A former Seminole Casino Coconut Creek employee pleaded guilty Tuesday to first-degree grand theft, admitting she gave five customers about \$570,000 in vouchers to play slot machines for free.

Ada Velez swiped stacks of vouchers for six months, passing them to a few regular slots players.

The vouchers allow patrons who sign up for Player's Club cards to get free spins based on how much they play the machines. A casino official told authorities that no customer should have received more than a \$100 voucher per visit and not even high-end players should have gotten more than \$1,000 in vouchers per month.

Former Tulalip Casino supervisor charged in thefts from gamblers...Washington State...2009

A former supervisor at the Tulalip Casino has been jailed on a federal charge of stealing thousands of dollars from a player-reward program he oversaw. According to prosecution documents, a casino regular in May 2008 noticed that she was suddenly missing about \$500 worth of points from her Reward Card balance. An investigation by casino agents found that Moses had been issuing vouchers on the players' accounts in the names of his family members and friends. As a supervisor, he would then sign off on the slips and give them to the friends and relatives to cash at the casino and split the money with him. The vouchers ranged between \$300 and \$800 each, the documents allege.

Ex-casino exec, waitress and gambler charged in slot scheme (updated)

WILKES-BARRE, Pa. (AP) — A former casino vice president accused of scheming with a cocktail waitress and gambler to steal over \$400,000 from a northeastern Pennsylvania casino has been jailed. **(Vice President of Player Development)** Robert Pellegrini was charged along with server Rochelle Poszeluznyj and patron Mark Heltzel. They each face more than 170 counts including theft, identity theft and criminal conspiracy. State Police allege Poszeluznyj collected players' casino cards and PIN numbers when they paid for drinks. They say she passed them to Pellegrini to make duplicates on which he added "Free Play". He gave to Heltzel to use at slot machines.

They're accused of splitting \$418,793 in winnings from May 2014 through April 2015.

Sands Casino gambler caught with over 150 cards players left in slots

A 46-year-old Allentown man gambling at the Sands Casino in Bethlehem is in jail on theft charges after state police say they caught him cashing in credits on comp cards other gamblers left behind. John Misiora was taken into custody on Monday, and state police said they found 155 Player's Club Cards in his possession. State Police said the investigation has not yet determined how Misiora obtained the four-digit pin numbers needed to access the "free play" credits the casino adds to the cards to reward players for their business or as incentives to return.

OHIO CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION

On 01/07/2014 Agents were notified by casino staff of suspicious activity involving 2 patrons and multiple total rewards cards.

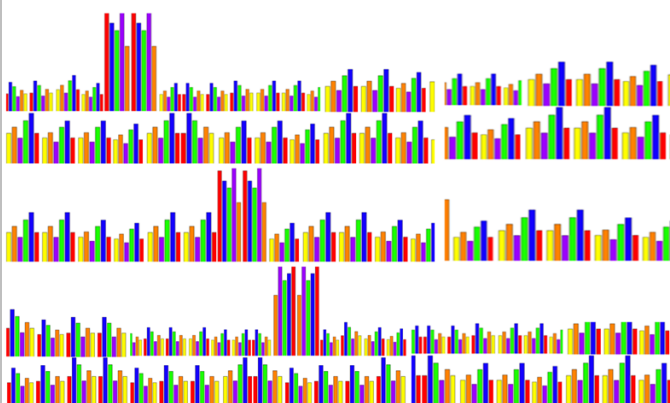
Upon further review, it was determined that on 01/02/14 the patrons had used 24 total rewards cards, all issued in different names, to download free slot play on to multiple slot machines. The patrons then used 2 total rewards cards to play the downloaded credits.

Preliminary identification of the patrons by their total rewards cards showed as Steven Virgil and Laura Barto as the card owners. A total of \$92,322.98 in free slot play was downloaded from the 24 total rewards cards.

Video surveillance shows the couple inserting the total rewards cards into the machines then inserting their play card after the downloads were complete. The couple is observed rapidly playing off the credits then removing their card when a winning spin is dealt. This activity essentially inflates the patrons loss while minimizing their winnings. Further investigation revealed that this activity is conducted on video poker machines. Video poker is a two stage game. The first stage is the dealing of the cards and the second is the draw of the cards. The total rewards system being utilized by this casino require the total rewards card to be in the machine during both phases of the game for the play to count towards the win loss ratio. During the first stage, with a total rewards
