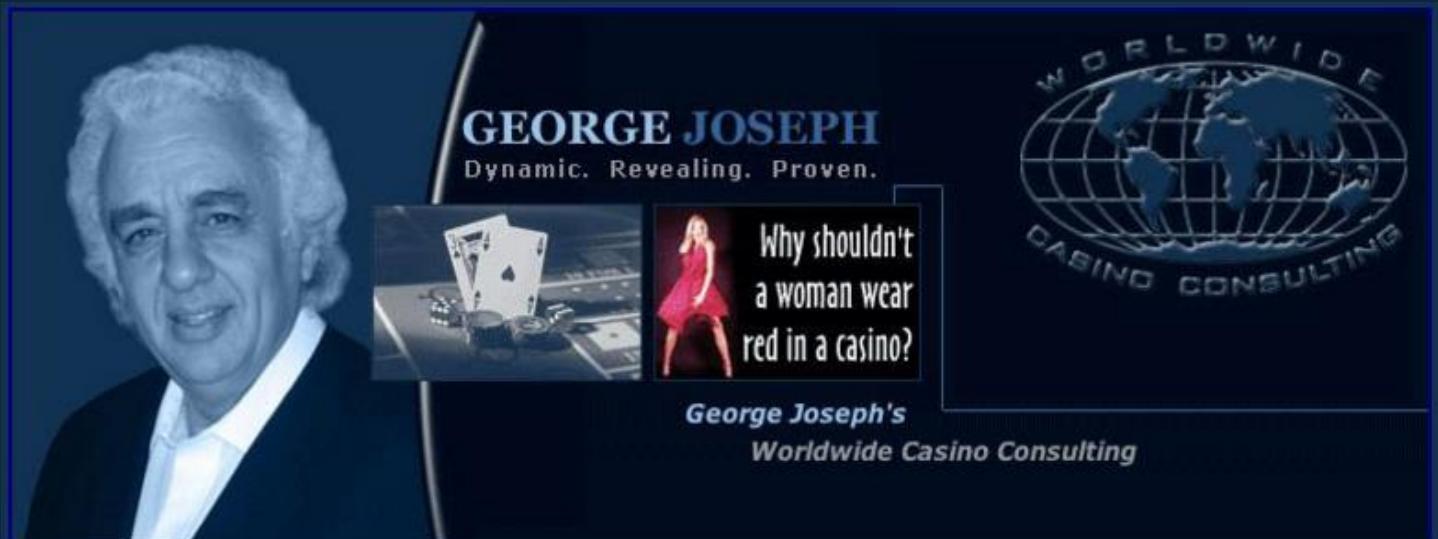


# *Surveillance Break-In Game Protection Training*

# Small Example of Surveillance Break-In Checklists

## Negative Observations are Reviewed with Manager

| 1.  | "When playing cards are introduced to a game in any fashion<br>(New or Pre-Shuffled or Poker Set Up)...were they Washed?"                  | Yes | No |
| 2.  | "Did the Dealer go Hand to Hand or Cross Their Body to Pay"  | Yes | No |
| 4.  | "Does the dealer Offer the Player Cut each time with the Right Hand<br>Only and the back of the cards to the customer at an arms' length?" | Yes | No |
| 5.  | "Does the player appear to attempt any Cut Card Trick?"  | Yes | No |
| 15. | "Was the dealer the last person to sign the Fill Slip or any Document?"  | Yes | No |
